

HOW TO GET A COPY OF YOUR DD214

Although it is best to have a copy of your service member's DD214 in a safe place where it can be located at the time of his or her death, here is information you can follow in the event you need an emergency DD214.

For emergency DD214 requests for funerals:

- 1. Call 314-801-0800 and explain you need a DD214 for a funeral service.
- 2. Call Department of Veterans Affairs, Pittsburgh, PA Veteran Benefits: for funerals: 800-827-1000. You will need the veteran's social security number.

American Legion Riders,

Greetings Legionnaires:

The Riders Annual Benefit Ride is Sunday, August 6th. This will be our 8th Annual Benefit Ride and will begin at the Kurt J. Lesker Company in Large (Jefferson Hills), PA, where we will ride a 90 mile, police escorted trek, ending at Post 712 for a great picnic style dinner, American auctions and 50/50's. We have one scheduled stop at Laurel Hill State Park in Somerset County. The stop will give riders the opportunity to stretch their legs, drink some water and eat some snacks and then it's back on the bikes to return to Post 712 for the after-ride party. Proceeds from this year's ride benefit local Veterans through the Riders partnership with the Veterans Place at Washington Boulevard, the Valor Clinic and of course, Post 712. The ride is open to the public and is also open to cars and trucks. Cost of the ride is \$25 for the rider, \$15 for each passenger and \$15 for dinner only. Your donation includes the ride, dinner, drinks, snacks, refreshments and the ability to participate in the after-ride party activities. Spread the word and come along for a great time.

The Riders also have a Gun Raffle occurring on the day of the Ride, August 6th, in which we are raffling a Colt 1911, .45 caliber, M45A1 pistol. The winning number is based on the first drawing of the afternoon Pick 3 number of the PA Daily lottery. Retail value of the Colt pistol is \$1,669. The winning number will also receive a Colt Range Bag, a set of Peltor Tactical 100 Ear Protection, 400 rounds of Remington UMC .45 ACP ammunition and 40 rounds of Federal Hydra-Shock .45 ACP ammunition; for a retail value exceeding \$2,000. This is a great gun that is already considered a Collector's Item. Proceeds from the raffle benefit the Veterans Place at Washington Boulevard, the Valor Clinic and Post 712. Thank you Senior Road Captain Dan Oeler, Secretary Susan Dillon and Treasurer Beverly Weikel for running the Gun Raffle for the Riders.

During the weekend of June 23rd some of the Riders rode to the historic town of Gettysburg to take in the sights, eat too much food and tour the battlefield. The Gettysburg Battlefield is an awe inspiring memorial to the tens of thousands of Americans who fought and died there in the pursuit of freedom, liberty and unity. If you have never visited the Gettysburg Battlefield you should add it to your list of places to visit. The Riders visit Gettysburg every year. Thanks to **Sergeant-At-Arms Ed Harmon** who rode trail and kept us all safe on the road.

That same weekend other Riders stayed closer to home and visited the Thunder in the Valley Motorcycle Rally in Johnstown, PA. This is an annual rally filled with fun, food and motorcycles. A great time was had by all.

Have you purchased your tickets for the Post 712 Gun Bash being held at Salvatore's Catering on November 18th? I have. If you have never been to a Gun Bash they are fun events. They are also very safe events. At a Gun Bash each individual raffle is called every few minutes. The winner is then able to claim the firearm he or she won. There is a Licensed Firearm Dealer on-site who conducts the appropriate background checks and registration as required by law. The winner is then given their firearm to take home with them that same day. No ammunition is given away or raffled-off at the Gun Bash for safety reasons. For the cost of \$35 a ticket you receive about a dozen or more chances to win a valuable firearm; plus the opportunity to participate in additional, side raffles, and you receive great, all-you-can-eat

Do you ride a motorcycle and have considered joining the Riders but have not done so just yet? What are you waiting for? We are a family oriented group of Veterans and Patriots with three over-riding philosophies. First is that we ride our motorcycles. Bikes were meant to ride not to sit in the garage getting dusty. Second is that we support Veteran and Military causes through works of charity. We expect participation to the best of your ability as work and family permit. We are pro-Veteran, pro-Military and pro-America; these are our beliefs. Sometimes the charity we conduct is a benefit event to earn financial donations and sometimes it is merely donating our time in helping others. Third, we respect one another. We do not raise our voice to one another in anger and we adhere to a military style chain of command of mutual respect ... or said another way, Do unto others as you would have others do unto you.
