HOW TO GET A DD214 IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY (DEATH)

Although it is best to have a copy of your service member's DD214 in a safe place where it can be located at the time of his or her death, here is information you can follow in the event you need an emergency DD214.

For emergency DD214 requests for funerals:

1. Call 314-801-0800 and explain you need a DD214 for a funeral service.

2. Call Department of Veterans Affairs - Pittsburgh, PA- Veteran Benefits - for funerals 800-827-1000. You will need the veteran's social security number.


