

American Legion Riders Post 712

At the February meeting ideas for upcoming rides and events were discussed. We are encouraging the riders group to recruit new members in 2014. Eligibility requirements are: *Any Veteran from the following*:

Aug. 2, 1990 to today (Gulf War / War On Terrorism)

Dec. 20, 1989 to Jan. 31, 1990 (Panama)

Aug. 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984 (Lebanon / Grenada)

Feb. 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975 (Vietnam War)

June 25, 1950 to Jan. 31, 1955 (Korean War)

Dec. 7, 1941 to Dec. 31, 1946 (World War II)

A son/daughter, grand/great grand son/daughter of a Veteran from previous list. A copy of the Veterans DD-214 discharge papers is needed to establish eligibility when applying for membership of Sons or ALA or as Regular membership.

Anyone interested in becoming an American Legion Rider should talk to any member for sponsorship. To join the Legion Riders you must meet a few basic requirements:

- •You must own a motorcycle with valid insurance and be properly licensed (or be the legally registered owner's spouse/ properly licensed)
- •You must be sponsored by a current member and subsequently voted into the ALRs
- •You must already be a member in good standing with the American Legion, the Sons or the ALA (Posts that do not have their own Legion Riders program are welcomed to join the Legion Riders of Post 712)
 - ·And finally, you must pay your 2014 dues of \$12

Important Update for Veterans on New Secure Health Identification Cards

More than 4 million veterans nation-wide use Veterans Identification Cards (VIC) for everything from prescription pickups to store discounts. However, a security vulnerability in these government-issued cards could make veterans susceptible to fraud. Last month, Rep. Tim Murphy discussed his concerns with WTAE-TV about how a smartphone can be used to scan the bar code on the back of the VA card to identify a veteran's Social Security number.

This week the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs initiated the process for replacing the old VIC cards with more secure Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC). Replacement cards are being mailed out, a process that will be completed in the next nine to 12 months. The new cards have additional security features to better protect a veteran's personal information.
