
THE BEST POSSIBLE PROACTIVE SOLUTION TO THIS PROBLEM IS TO EITHER:

May 20th is Armed Forces Day. The establishment of Armed Forces Day was led by President Harry Truman and first celebrated during 1950, to establish a single holiday for citizens to come together and thank our military for their patriotic service. The celebration of Armed Forces Day coincided with the establishment of the Department of Defense. Armed Forces Day is the third Saturday in May and is the culmination of Armed Forces Week which begins on the second Saturday in May. Though Armed Forces Day was supposed to do away with celebrations of the individual services holidays, those individual holidays, or birthdays, are still celebrated:

Army – June 14, 1775 Army Reserve – April 23, 1908 Army National Guard – December 16, 1636 Navy – October 13, 1775 Navy Reserve – March 3, 1915 USMC – November 10, 1775 USMC Reserve – August 29, 1916 Coast Guard – August 4, 1790 Coast Guard Reserve – February 19, 1941 Air Force – September 18, 1947 Air Force Reserve – April 14, 1948


