Price is \$8.00 for 1 and 3 for \$22.00.



### **Veterans Designation**

Act 176 of 2012 has allowed PennDOT to issue a PA driver's license or identification card that clearly indicates that the bearer is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces. An icon consisting if the American Flag with the word "veteran" beneath it is for placement on the front of the bearer's driver's license or identification card.

## Qualified applicants should visit <a href="https://www.dmv.state.pa.us">www.dmv.state.pa.us</a>

and click on the American Flag icon with the phrase "Veterans Designation" Applicants will be able to renew or order a duplicate driver's license or identification card which will contain the designation. There is no fee for the Veterans Designation itself; however, qualified applicants must pay for any applicable initial issuance, renewal or duplicate driver's license or identification card fees.

Only applicants who have received a DD214 or equivalent for service in the U.S. Armed Forces, including a reserve component or the National Guard, who were discharged or released from such service under conditions other than dishonorable, should apply the Veterans Designation to their driver's license or identification card.
