The American Legion is preparing to celebrate its 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. This is a noteworthy and wonderful achievement. Congratulations American Legion! Though even as we cheer this grand news, we routinely hear about Veterans Organizations having to close their doors due to financial strife and we know Post 712 is not immune. **The percentage of Veterans in the US continues to decrease and currently comprises a mere 7% of Americans**. We will see more and more Veterans Organizations permanently closing their doors each year. <u>This will happen</u>.

What is the Legion? Officially, the Legion is a 501(c) 19, tax exempt, non-profit, Veterans Organization. Ultimately, the Legion is a fraternal and sororal organization for Veterans and Families where we may share the bond that binds us all together thru the solemn pride of Service to Nation.
